


Robert Kiyosaki books for all his finance secrets

**Who is it for –** This book is for people who want to escape the 9 to 5 routine and want to know how to become rich.


What this book is about – This had to be the first book in the list of books by Robert Kiyosaki. This book is all about how the author grew up learning about values from his biological father (Poor Dad)



# 3. Rich Dad's Guide to Investing – What the Rich invest in, that the poor and the middle class do not!






Who is it for – This is for people who want to earn their fortune through investing and business.

Who is it for - This is for teenagers who want to gain basic financial knowledge and develop and base for their future financial journey.


What the book is about - This book explains the basics of financial statements. It explains the




importance of having a family financial statement and encourages teenagers to understand the finances of the house. The book recommends teenagers to seek work and get the feel of how working life is.


**Who is it for** – This book is for the people who strive to achieve financial success and wants to be free from the corporate world.








**Who is it for** – This is for people who want to work towards financial knowledge to make good financial decisions.

# 8. Rich Dad's Before you Quit your Job




**Who is it for** – This is for people who are looking to quit the rat race and start something of their own.





# 11. Rich Dad's Who Took My Money




Who is it for – This is for people who are worried about their financial future. Investors can also read this book.

#### 12. Fake: Fake Money Fake Teachers Fake Assets






**Who is it for** – This book is for people who are in investing or the people who want to have a financial education.




**Who is it for** – This is for people who are dependent on their employer or government for their financial future.

**Who is it for** – This is for people who believe that they are disadvantaged when it comes to making money.


What is it about - This book is about how people can change their thinking and take control of their


Who is it for – This is for people who want to turn their financial condition and become rich.




**Who is it for** – This book is for people who want to improve their financial condition by managing their debts.


What is it about - This book touches on various topics like the reason behind the recession, how to


Who is it for – This is for people who do not want to work their whole lives to make money for survival.




**Who is it for** – This is for people who want to shift their mindset towards creating wealth rather than towards a good job.




Who is it for — This book is for people who are confused between living for financial gains and living a spiritual life.
